English

This term in English we shall explore a range of genres through our cross curricular theme of " You are what you eat' The genres of writing we will cover this term will be persuasive writing and creating an imaginary world. We will also continue to develop our grammar skills within each topic as well as in discreet lessons. Focusing on fronted adverbials, sentence types and the consistent use of a range of punctuation. We shall continue to focus on developing the children's handwriting and maintaining high standards of presentation.

Science

The topics we will be covering this term will be 'teeth and digestion', followed by 'The Water Cycle' and 'States of Matter'. Here the children will develop their subject knowledge of each alongside expanding their understanding of scientific processes and enquiry. There will also be opportunities for the children to learn through practical investigations.

Design Technology

This term the children will be given the opportunity to design a label for their soup and using a variety of tools effectively and safely, prepare and cook a variety of chosen ingredients for their soup. They will then evaluate their and their peer's finished product.

Maths

In Year 4, we will continue to practise core calculation skills in weekly Four Operations lessons. We will be focussing on developing the children's understanding and application of number skills.

P.E.

First Touch and the class teacher will be developing skills such as; catching, throwing, invasion games and learning the importance of teamwork.

Religious Education

This term, we will be learning about Sikhism and gaining an understanding of what values, symbols and practices are of importance to them.

Art and Design

In art children will be developing their skills of line and tone and considering scale and perspective. They will be applying their observational skills when drawing a range of soup cans and soup ingredients.

We will be looking at the school scheme of work in ICT. The children will develop their internet skills and will be editing work using 'Word' and 'Publisher'.
