This will include poetry, persuasive writing and historical settings.

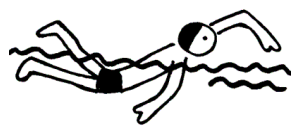
Science

In science, we will be exploring the world of living things, including habitats, classification of animals and food chains.

Numeracy

In Year 4, we will continue to practise core calculation skills in weekly Four Operations and mental maths lessons alongside the other areas of measurement, such as angles, perimeter and area. Additionally, revisiting previous learning for consolidation.

We will also be focusing on group and individual targets.



P.E.

Children will continue with swimming this term. Every Tuesday they will be required to bring a swimming kit, goggles, swimming hat and £1.00 to participate in the lesson. Miss Sharp and Mr. Willcox will now lead swimming and First Touch will oversee general P.E. sessions on Thursday afternoons.

Design Technology

This term we will be developing our sewing skills, designing and making a Roman purse.

Art and Design

In Art, we shall be exploring mosaics, relating to our topic on the Romans. Children will be creating their own mosaics through the skill of weaving.
