

YEAR 6 SUMMER TERM

English

We will be exploring information texts and learning about interesting tourist locations in England to write about. The children will apply their learning about rivers to create a persuasive leaflet to encourage people to keep them clean. Children will use their grammar and descriptive skills to write their own short story. The classes have swapped class readers and will continue to read and engage in activities with 'A Monster Calls' and 'Holes.'

Computing (Mr Harvey)

This term we will be learning how to record and manipulate sound in different ways using computers. We will also try programming our own sound machine!



SCIENCE

Science will be a big focus this term. The children will learn about how light travels from a source to our eyes. They will set up and complete investigations related to electricity, including multiple components and will recognise and draw electrical circuits and symbols. Finally, the children will learn how animals and plants adapt to their environment and change over time.

French (Mr Harvey)

We will be continuing to build confidence in speaking French this term, through songs and activities



History/Geography

This term, we will be learning about rivers and mountains. We will be thinking about how rivers are formed and how they develop over many years. We will also be studying the water cycle. Through an excursion to Oxhey Park, we will learn about rivers in our local area. Mapping will also be on our agenda, as we learn how to read maps and use grid references.

Maths

This term we will be consolidating work carried out during the key stage and build on the children's problem solving and application skills.

Arithmetic will continue to be a large focus of the term.



PE

This will continue with First Touch, who will be focusing on tennis, rounders and cricket. Swimming will take place every Monday.

MUSIC (Mr Harvey)

This term we will continue to investigate '12 Bar Blues' and its influence on modern music through listening, playing and improvisation.

The children will take part in our end of year production which will involve singing, acting and dancing !!

RE (Mr Harvey)

In RE we will be drawing comparisons between the different religions we have studied and consider the influence religion has on life today.

ART and Design.

The children will create a river collage using a variety of techniques and materials linked to rivers and mountains. The children will learn how to sew and weave to design and create their own personalised bookmark.
