A reminder that County Admissions are recommending that parents complete their applications **by Friday, 23 October (next week)**.

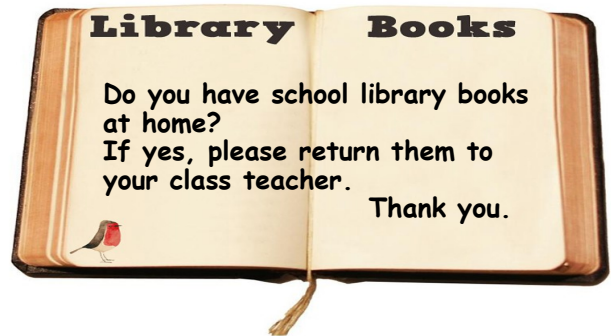
#### What happens when?

**Sept to Oct 2020** - secondary and upper schools hold their open events.

**31 October 2020** - last date to submit application.

**1 March 2021** - allocation day. School places will be offered.



### FREE SCHOOL MEALS ENTITLEMENT

You should apply even if you do not wish your child to receive a school dinner. Other entitlements are available with the application.

*If you have recently made an application and you have received a reference number from County, please ring Mrs Conroy in the school office, who will confirm whether school has received confirmation of entitlement.*

**On Monday, next week**, a letter is being sent home via your child regarding the plans to set up a remote learning platform. The system will be known as 'Google Classroom'.

An individual password will be enclosed, therefore, it is important that your child hands over the letter to you at the end of the day.

**On Friday, next week**, the NHS nurses will be in school to administer the flu vaccination. As explained in an earlier newsletter, the vaccine will be given inside your child's class bubble, following COVID guidelines.

If it is not possible to vaccinate the whole school on the 23rd, the nurses will return in November.

*The children who are not receiving the vaccine will be taken out of class until the nurses leave.*

**On Monday, 2 November (after half term)**, a booking letter for parent/teacher consultations will be sent home. Consultations will be via telephone calls on Tuesday and Wednesday, 10 and 11 November. Once you receive this letter, please complete and return asap in order that your child's class teacher can set up suitable slots. Thank you.
