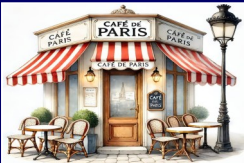

Why this matters...

- 9 in 10 children own a mobile phone by age 11 (Ofcom, 2024)
- 96% of 12-15 year olds have a mobile phone and 92% have their own social media profiles.
- Almost 3 in 4 teenagers (13-17 years) have encountered harm online.
- 1 in 5 young people aged 16-18 have felt life is not worth living due to social media (Parentkind, 2024)
- 74% of girls who got a smartphone aged 6 years had mental health issues as adults versus 46% who got one at 18 years (University of Birmingham, 2025)
- Teens with problematic smartphone use are 3x more likely to suffer from depression (King's College London, 2024)



Good attendance is vital for all children to support their learning and social development. Following government guidance, we have a duty to inform parents/carers if their child has had several absences from school. If your child's absence is 10% or more, so that attendance is below 90%, they are classed as persistent absentee, and you are at risk of a breach notice and a fixed penalty notice.
