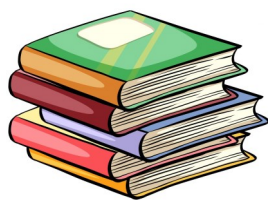
Well done to all - Great attendance figures this week !!
