

# Field Junior School

Happy New Year to all parents, carers, staff and children! We hope you all have had a fantastic festive season break and we are happy to welcome you back to this spring term. It was good to see all the children settled down into the school routines so quickly and hear all about what they got up to during the break. As the weather turns cooler can we ask that you please send your child to school appropriately dressed.

A reminder, the school gates open at 8:30am. All children are to be lined up and ready to go into their classrooms at 8:50am for registration and to start their learning day. For safeguarding reasons the school gates will close just before 9 am. The car park is for staff and not to be used when dropping off or collecting your child, even if you are arriving late or early.

If you arrive after 8.50 am please can you bring your child in through the reception ensuring that you record their arrival in the green late book. This is to make sure that we can record your child's attendance, as they would have missed registration. If your child is going to be absent from school please can you call the school office each morning to report your child absence. Press 1 to leave a message on the school answer phone before 09:00 am.

## Important dates for your diary

### **Year 4 Swimming**

Thank you to all the parents who have paid for swimming. A reminder that lessons will start on Thursday 16th January at Everyone Active Central Watford. The children will have an early lunch on the Thursday and then will walk to the Leisure centre. Please make sure that your child is appropriately dressed. We ask that children come into school with their swimwear underneath their uniform and with a towel and underwear. Goggles and swimming hats are optional.

As swimming is a legal requirement of the national curriculum all children are expected to take part unless medically exempt with a medical note.

## Viking Day Year 5 30th January

Cost per child = £8.00 This organised day will take place in the annexe and will be led by a specialised history company. The children will be Vikings for a day and will take part in many activities. We would like the children to wear costumes. This will make the day even more realistic and we thank you in advance for your help. Lunch will be as normal in school. If your child has a music lesson arranged for that day, it will be forfeited.

## Phasels Wood Year 4 Residential Trip Monday 30th June – Wednesday 2nd July

The deadline to pay the non refundable deposit of £40 is the 17th January.

Unfortunately there will be no option to add on after this date.

## Celtic Harmony Year 3 Wednesday 2nd April

Cost per child = £25 The children will have the unique opportunity to experience life in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. They will get to make Stone Age tools and Bronze Age beaker pots, along with experiencing what life was like in round house buildings. The children will be given the opportunity to trade and role play using real Stone-Age artefacts as farmers, hunters, miners etc and exchange goods of different values using numeracy skills. It really is a fantastic school trip that will fully enhance the children's historical understanding. (Please note this is the only trip in Year 3). Email was sent on the 6h January.



Good attendance is vital for all children to support their learning and social development. If your child's absence is 10% or more, so that attendance is below 90%, they are classed as persistent absentee, and you are at risk of a breach notice and a fixed penalty notice.


