A guide for parents and carers of children applying to secondary school for 2026

What happens when?

1 September 2025	Online application system opens.
September and October	Secondary and upper schools hold their open events (Details available at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/schoolsdirectory)
31 October 2025	Deadline for applications
2 December 2025	 Last date to: submit reasons for making a late application and for that application to be considered 'on time' notify us of a change of address and for that address to be taken into account for allocation day Please refer to the online admission pages for more detail about these processes.
30 January 2026	Last date to make a late application to be considered for allocation day.
2 March 2026	Allocation Day. School places are offered.

PARKING CONCESSIONS FOR PARENTS/CARERS

The concessions to parents/carers apply between Monday to Friday, during term times only. The concession periods for **permit bays** in Lammas Road, Tucker Street and Elfrida Road: 8:40am to 9:00am and 3:10pm to 3:30pm.

The concession periods for **shared use pay and display/permit bays** in Watford Field Road between:

8:40am to 9:00am, 11:25am to 11:40am,

All the above applies between Monday to Friday, during term times only. At any other time, parents/carers will have to pay and display, even if it is only for another five minutes. Parking is not permitted on double or single yellow lines or on school zig zags.

Dinner Accounts

Please ensure that your child's dinner account has sufficient credit before they order their meal each day. A dinner is £3.50 per day. It's essential that there is money on the account prior to your child having their dinner - we ask that you don't wait for the office to contact you about low balances, as this can cause unnecessary delays and disruption to the smooth running of our lunch service.

There are several convenient ways to add credit to your child's account. You can make payments through your child's Arbour profile online, call the school office to pay over the phone, or send cash to school in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and class written on it.
