Next week is going to be super busy- with the afternoon performances on Mon 16th and Tuesday 17th. The afternoon performances will start at 1:30pm, so please arrive at 1:20pm to get seated- no earlier please. Parents to enter via the top playground double gates and then through the side doors from the alleyway between the two playgrounds. If you are attending the performance on either of these afternoons, please would you be so kind as to help us stack chairs at the end once all the children have left the stage and let the children return to their classrooms. You may then assemble on the usual playgrounds where you pick your children up from and they will be sent out to you. (even if the play finishes before 3:20pm). We will keep any children whose parents have not attended until the usual time.

Wednesday the children will be making hats and decorating their classrooms for the Xmas lunch. The children will be able to wear Christmas jumpers on Wednesday. In the evening they will be returning to school for the evening performance.

Please ensure your children arrive at 4:45pm- you may enter via the top playground gates and enter the school through the side doors from the alleyway between the two playgrounds. Do not arrive before 4:45pm as the doors will be locked until then. Your children will make their way to the classrooms they have been allocated and you can take your seats in the hall if you have tickets. Please would you be so kind to help stack the chairs away at the end of the performance once all children have left the stage and then assemble on the usual playgrounds where your children will be sent out to you to take home. We are expecting the evening performance to end at approx. 6:15pm. (If we start on time)

If you are **not** bringing your child back for the evening performance please would you let the class teacher know by Monday 16th so that they can make last minute adjustments to speaking parts and arrangements on the stage.

We will be collecting donations after each performance to buy new reading books for the classrooms so please bring some loose change with you- Much appreciated!

A reminder- we finish school at 1:30pm on Friday 20th December and return to school Tuesday 7th Jan.




There are still Christmas Quizzes available. Quizzes will be sold at the Christmas play and after school on certain days.
