Welcome back to school, everyone! I hope you all had a wonderful Easter break and are ready for an exciting final term.

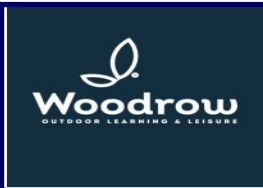
