If you wish to order milk from September 2026, please find below a guide on how to do this. The price for this for the full Autumn term will be £25.56 or £13.32 for the first half term and £12.24 for the second half term. (This is subject to change).

The timeline for the milk order is between **Monday 13th July and Monday 24th August** at 1pm.

After this time, the system will stop receiving orders for w/c Mon 1st Sept, and you will not be able to get milk for that week. Therefore, please make sure you order by this date and time. The system works by ordering before Monday 1pm which would then ensure your child has milk for the following Monday onwards (i.e. a week later). If you miss the Monday (24th August) deadline, your child's milk won't be added for a week after the oncoming Monday, so if you order on a Tuesday, for example say Tuesday 25th August, your child's milk will start on Monday 7th September.

PLEASE DO NOT TRY TO ORDER FOR SEPTEMBER BEFORE MONDAY 13TH JULY AS YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR MILK IN THE CURRENT TERM.



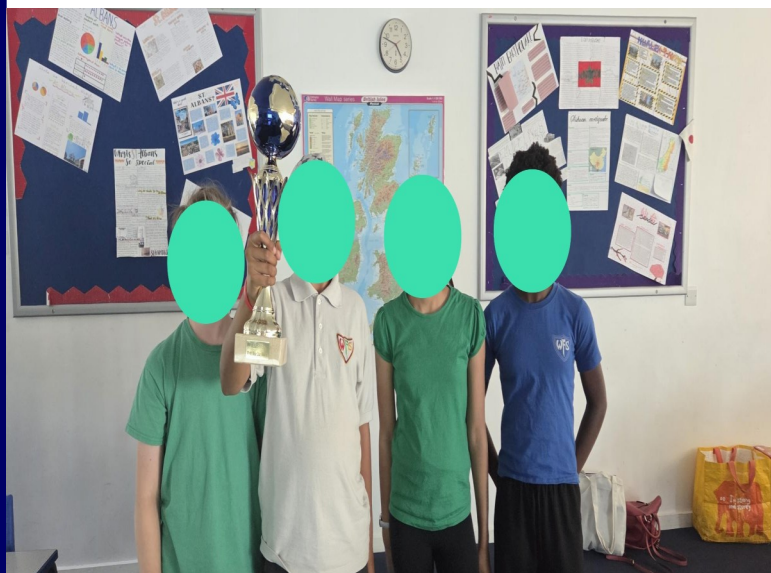
Dinner Accounts

On Universal Credit? Your Child Could Get Free School Meals

From September 2026, the eligibility criteria for Free School Meals (FSM) will be changing. From the start of the new school year, all parents/carers **who are in receipt of Universal Credit will be eligible for Free School Meals**, regardless of the amount received.

Applying takes around 5 minutes, and you will need your National Insurance number. Applications can be made using the following link:

There is no requirement for pupils who are already receiving Free School Meals to re-apply

Even if your child does not currently take a school meal regularly, I would still encourage you to apply. Not only will your child have access to a hot, nutritious meal at lunchtime when they need it, but there is an additional benefit to the school as well. When families access Free School Meals, the school may receive additional funding to support our pupils further. This funding helps us to provide enhanced learning experiences and support for all children in our care.

Good attendance is vital for all children to support their learning and social development. Following government guidance, we have a duty to inform parents/carers if their child has had several absences from school. If your child's absence is 10% or more, so that attendance is below 90%, they are classed as persistent absentee, and you are at risk of a breach notice and a fixed penalty notice.
