### Dinner Accounts



Please ensure that your child's dinner account has sufficient credit before they order their meal each day. A dinner is £3.50 per day. It's essential that there is money on the account prior to your child having their dinner - we ask that you don't wait for the office to contact you about low balances, as this can cause unnecessary delays and disruption to the smooth running of our lunch service.

This is particularly important for our Year 6 children. All accounts must have the correct amount of money for July meals to be taken. As previously mentioned each meal costs £3.50. Therefore, please can you calculate the days your child will be having dinners and top up accordingly. Please contact the school office if you require assistance.

There are several convenient ways to add credit to your child's account. You can make payments through your child's Arbour profile online, call the school office to pay over the phone, or send cash to school in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and class written on it.
