Outdoor Play/Swimming Update



We strongly believe in the importance of physical exercise and outdoor experiences for our children's overall well-being and development. Regular physical activity is crucial for:

- Promoting physical health
- Supporting mental well-being
- Enhancing learning and concentration

Building confidence and social skills

With this in mind, we would like to emphasise the following key points:

1. **Outdoor Exercise and Learning** We actively encourage children to participate in outdoor activities, both during structured PE lessons and break times. Physical movement is essential for children's growth and development, and we are committed to providing opportunities for active play and learning. With regard to swimming lessons, I strongly advise providing your child with a swimming hat to wear in the pool and appropriate outdoor clothing for the walk to the pool and back, especially if it is raining.

2. **Appropriate Outdoor Clothing** As we approach the cooler and potentially wet months, we kindly request that children come to school prepared with:

- **Waterproof coats with hoods**
- Suitable footwear
- Layers that can be added or removed as needed

If you wish to provide your child with a change of clothing for return to school from swimming on rainy days- please do!

These preparations will ensure our children can enjoy outdoor activities comfortably and safely, regardless of the weather conditions.

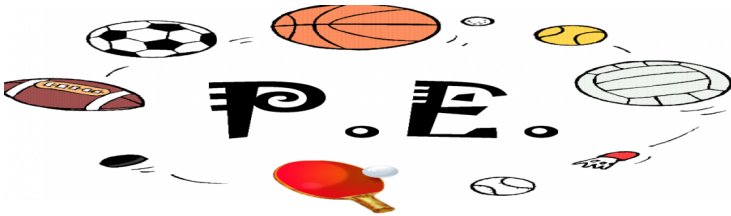
