

We recognise that during certain times, some families observe fasting practises, and we're keen to work with you to support your child's wellbeing. We would ideally like children to continue attending these clubs, as they provide valuable additional support for their learning. However, if your child is unable to attend due to fasting, please do send a letter into school to let us know. This helps us to keep accurate records and ensure we're providing the right support at the right time for every child in our care.



One of the highlights of this week was welcoming author Olaf Falafel to lead our Friday assembly. It was truly entertaining and inspiring for the children. Having the opportunity to connect with a real author and hear about the magic of storytelling is something we believe is so valuable. 
