An email was sent to all parents/carers on Wednesday 19th March regarding Free School Meal Information/Applications: **If you do not currently receive FSM (Free School Meals) for your child and unsure whether you are eligible, please apply via this link <http://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals>, alternatively collect a form from the school office and complete and we will apply on your behalf.**

it is important to apply before 1 April 2025 to ensure protection for your child's eligibility all the way through to Year 6. Only applications processed before this date will maintain this protection.

If you already in receipt of Free School Meals, you do not need to re-apply as your child will remain eligible to the end of Year 6. Any questions, please feel free to contact the school office.
