I hope this newsletter finds you well. I wanted to share some important updates and reminders about what's happening at Field Junior School.

Today, we were treated to a delightful musical experience when year 12 students from the Purcell Music School visited us for a special assembly. Their performance was truly inspiring, featuring a wonderful array of instruments including flutes, violins, bongos, and piano. The students showcased an impressive range of musical styles, playing everything from pop and rock to classical pieces. Our children were thoroughly captivated and thoroughly enjoyed the assembly, experiencing the joy and diversity of music.

A reminder about our Christmas lunch and lunch options for the Panto: the deadline to complete your child's dinner option was Monday 24th November. If you have yet to inform us of your child's lunch option please ensure you do no later than Monday 1st December. Our kitchen team needs this information to order the correct amount of food. Should you have misplaced the original letter, please email or call the school office to confirm your child's lunch preference. School photographs were sent home last week. If you wish to order a copy, you have until 4th December for free delivery to school. Orders can still be placed after this date, but there will be an additional charge for home delivery.

I'd like to emphasise an important safety reminder: unless your child is in Year 6 and has been explicitly permitted to walk to and from school alone, they should be accompanied in the mornings and not left unattended in the park while walking to school.

Regarding our Christmas performance, a letter was sent home on Tuesday for children with speaking parts. Please return the attached slip to confirm your child's availability for the evening performance on 16th December. This helps us plan effectively and arrange replacements if needed. A script was also sent home for line learning - please ensure your child brings this to school every day.

Finally, a date for your diary: next Friday, 5th December, is an occasional day, and the school will be closed.

Santa Claus is Coming to Town will be held in the school hall on Monday, the 15th of December at 1.15pm and Tuesday, the 16th of December at 5pm. The tickets are free, but due to the fire regulations we have limited number of tickets available for both days.

It is strictly two tickets per family on either of the dates, and on the first come first served basis. Please bring the slip back by **Monday**, **8**<sup>th</sup> **of December**. It is <u>no ticket</u>, <u>no entry</u>, so please make sure you return the slip on time. The tickets will be sent via your child, attached to the request slip.

If demand exceeds our capacity, we may put on another afternoon show.
