In November, what started out as a mailshot to local businesses and an email to our local schools appealing for their help over Christmas resulted in an overwhelming response of kindness and generosity.



South West Herts Partnership—Year in Review

As we approach the end of another year, the team at SWHP would like to **thank all** our schools for their continuing and unwavering support. As you are all aware we have spent most of this year facing an uncertain future with threats to funding cuts for the Local School Partnership services.



While the future is still not set in stone, we are proud to have retained all our highly skilled workers and continue to offer a robust and quality service. We are pleased to let you know that currently we are looking to secure until **Autumn 25**. We thank you for your responses to the engagement survey.

The year has been as busy as ever; new schools have bought into the service, and we have continued to identify areas we can upskill in and offer to our communities. All the family workers are now **Drawing & Talking Practitioners**. This is being used widely across both primary and secondary schools. We are all trained in **Core Mediation Skills** and **First Aid at Work**. The service continues to run flexibly with coffee mornings, parent presentations and drop-in sessions being arranged to suit school needs.

Two of our team have become **EBSA Champions**; working on a triangulated support programme with DSPL9 and Nessie to support families and young people managing school absence/avoidance.

As the cost of living crisis continues to affect our communities the team all became **Warmth Champions**, and we remain dedicated to supporting families with essential goods and food parcels. Through support via Three Rivers and Watford Borough Councils we have been able to offer help to our most vulnerable families accessing the **Household Support Fund** and have successfully supported more than 65 families.

SWHP became a **White Ribbon Supporter Organisation** dedicated to ending violence against women. We continue to support victim of Domestic Abuse and remain passionate as a team that we must work with men and boys to prevent violence and change harmful attitudes.

As you will see from our first page, we had a wonderful response to our **Christmas Appeal** and have had the pleasure of playing Santa – delivering gifts to our families in need – thanks to the generosity of schools and community businesses we have been able to spread some festive cheer to many!

All that remains to be said is a **big thank** you to our team of Family workers and the Business team; they work tirelessly to make the lives of our young people better.

Children will depart with their very own Driver's License for Santa's Sleigh.


Charity Gift Wrap
